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Introduction

Congratulations on taking this next incredible step in your musical journey! The fact that this book is in your hands is no accident. You attracted it because you are ready for it.

Who am I and why should you listen to me?

My name is Adam Rafferty, and I'm a guitarist, composer, and teacher. I started playing guitar at age five and just turned fifty! (OMG, how did that happen?) So that's forty-five years of music study and playing, thirty years of teaching, and I am *still learning something new about music*, *guitar*, *and life every day*.

As a teen I had my first big challenge studying classical guitar. Following that, I played jazz guitar in New York City through my twenties and thirties. I still think of myself as a jazz player even though I've been playing mainly solo fingerstyle guitar for the last twelve years.

It was during my jazz-guitar period that I met my mentor, a worldclass jazz pianist, composer, and arranger. He gave me musical and personal training of the highest order.

It was an intense master-apprentice relationship. Our minds melded. Many of my vague ideas became clear and precise simply through being around him.

Even though he was officially "just a music teacher," our lessons

went far beyond music. Music was simply the vehicle through which a deeper teaching was conveyed.
